Background:

In 2010, the Islands of Southeast Asia Network on MSM, TG, and HIV (ISEAN) and the Humanist Institute for Co-operation with Developing Countries (Hivos) jointly submitted a regional proposal to the Global Fund for AIDS, Malaria, and Tuberculosis (GFATM) Round 10. The programme, entitled 'Strengthening Community Systems to Reduce Vulnerability to and Impact of H TG CBOs IV infection on MSM and TG in Insular Southeast Asia', was approved by GFATM and contract for the grant was signed on 6 October 2011. The grant, since then, has been called the ISEAN Hivos Program (IHP). This grant has the main goal of reducing (a) the vulnerability and risks of MSM and TG to HIV infection and (b) the impact of HIV on their lives in Insular Southeast Asia. It intends to address critical gaps in supporting and scaling up activities that reduce HIV/AIDS among MSMs and TGs.

myISEAN was officially registered on 12th June 2014 with the Register of Society (ROS) Malaysia as an MSM & TG network in Malaysia. myISEAN is a community-based network. Our vision is "A Malaysia where all MSM and TG are treated as equal members of society and have equal access to sexual health services". myISEAN is governed by a board made up entirely of community members representing and protecting the interest and welfare of MSM & TG and those are living with HIV.

In order for myISEAN to expand its network to serve its CBO members better, it intend its own website. The said website is to communicate update about the network & CBO members as the the target audience.
